

Devi Mahatmyam. Part-9: Keelaka Stotram

As mentioned in the earlier Mandir Bulletins, Devi Kavacham, Argala Stotram, and Keelaka Stotram are the three *Angas* (limbs) of the Devi Mahatmyam (also called Durga Saptashati) which are to be recited before reciting the Devi Mahatmyam. We have so far covered two *Angas*, including the Devi Kavacham and Argala Stotram. This week, we will cover the last remaining *Anga*: Keelaka Stotram, which consists of a total of 16 shlokas (verses).
