




## Devi Mahatmyam. Part-3: Devi Kavacham Part-1

As described earlier, Devi Kavacham, Argala Stotram, and Keelakam are the three Angas (Limbs) that are recited, along with Ratri Suktam, before reciting Devi Mahatmyam (Durga Saptashati). Last week we covered Ratri Suktam. Starting this week, we will discuss Devi Kavacham. Since Devi Kavacham consists of 61 Shlokas, we will study it in 3-4 parts. This week, we will cover the first 15 Shlokas of Devi Kavacham as shown in the following video file. The video contains the original Sanskrit Text, its Transliteration as well as translation in English, along with the recorded audio of Part-1 of Devi Kavacham.

## देवि कवचम

*(Armour of Goddess Devi)*

*Devi Kavacham is a collection of 61 shlokas from the Markandeya Purana and is part of the Durga Saptashati. This Kavacham (armour) protects the reader in all parts of one's body, in all places and from all sorts of difficulties.*

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
