

Devi Mahatmyam. Part-2: Ratri Suktam

As described in last week's bulletin, three Angas and two Vedic hymns are associated with the recitation of Devi Mahatmyam, also called Durga Saptashati. The three principal Angas are Devi Kavacham, Argala Stotram, and Keelakam. The two Vedic Hymns are Raatri Suktam and Devi Suktam, both from Rig Veda. While Ratri Suktam is normally recited before Devi Mahatmyam and before the Angas, Devi Suktam is recited after the Devi Mahatmyam. So, we will, this week, start with the recitation of Ratri Suktam.
