


Devi Mahatmyam. Part-7: Argala Stotram Part-1

As described earlier, Devi Kavacham, Argala Stotram, and Keelakam form the three Angas (Limbs) of the Devi Mahatmyam and are recited in sequence before commencing the reading of the Devi Mahatmyam. Last week, we completed a reading of The Devi Kavacham in a 4-part series. Starting this week, we will read the Argala Stotram in a 2-part series, consisting of 14 and 13 shlokas, respectively. The following video contains the original Sanskrit Text, its Transliteration as well as Translation into English, along with the recorded audio of Part-1 of Argala Stotram. Argala Stotram was also written by Rishi Markandeya. It comprises a total of 27 shlokas. Argala Stotram is one of the most popular prayers of Goddess Durga.
